If you've been unable to pay your mortgage due to COVID-19, we're here to help you. IHDA developed the Emergency Mortgage Assistance Program (EMA) to support Illinois homeowners unable to pay their mortgage due to a COVID-19-related loss of income. If you are approved, you will receive a grant of up to \$15,000 paid directly to your loan servicer.

Funds are limited and applications for EMA will be accepted August 24<sup>th</sup> through September 4<sup>th</sup>. Only one application per household is allowed and an application is not a guarantee of assistance.
